The MS Markers (hereafter referred to as the "Tool") is an automated image analysis service that provides you with image-derived measurements of normal brain structures and pathological lesions based on brain magnetic resonance scans. The use of the Tool entails image data upload, automated image analysis, manual quality check by a qualified human operator and issuing of a structured PDF report as the final result. By using the Tool you agree to these Terms and Conditions of Use. Please read them carefully.

2. Developer / Provider

The Tool is developed and provided by UL FE, Trzaska cesta 25, SI-1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia (hereafter referred to as the "Developer") and with VAT ID SI11015489. The Developer guarantees to have developed and will continue to develop the Tool in a professional manner and with all due care and skill.
